

MULBERRY RESIDENTS :

There are seven houses on Mulberry lane (as shown below).

From the clues provided can you determine the name of each family (one family is the Millers) and the house number (there are both even and odd house numbers, though not necessarily in consecutive order) , in which each family resides??

CLUES :

The house numbers on one side are odd and the other even, except for the Millers (who live at the south end of the lane), who have an odd house number.

The other odd numbered houses (in some order) are The Klein's, the ones who live at 8557, and the ones who live directly across from the Hills.

The even numbered houses (in some order) are the one at 8572(the highest even numbered house on the street), the Smythes and the ones across from the Stones.

The Rodrigo's live between two other houses as does the family at 8564.

The Smythes House number is 8 less than the Rogers, who live directly across from the Klein's.

The odd house numbers are 8531, the one occupied by the Stones, (which is 12 house numbers higher than the Rodrigo's) and 8577.

The even numbered houses are decreasing in number from top to bottom, and ALL are eight house numbers apart. The odd numbered house are increasing in number, from top to bottom.

The Stones live closer to the Miller's than do the Kleins.
